UNDERSTANDING THE LIMITATIONS OF HUMAN COGNITION



Inattentional Blindness

- Failing to see what should have been plainly visible
 - Because attention is not **focused** on it
- Most of our perceptual processing occurs outside of conscious awareness
- Attentional resources are finite

FRAMING EFFECT

• Tendency to draw conclusions based on how data are presented.



COGNITIVE BIASES



ROTTWEILER EFFECT

• Tendency to think that assertiveness is an undesirable female trait



CRABS IN THE POT EFFECT

• Tendency to keep one another from getting to the top by pulling each other down



CONFIRMATION BIAS (HONDA CIVIC EFFECT)

Tendency to seek out or interpret information that confirms your preconception



STATUS QUO BIAS

• Tendency to assume the current state is adequate and thus favour a reactive rather a proactive approach
